



## Opportunity in Ecuador - The Shuar!

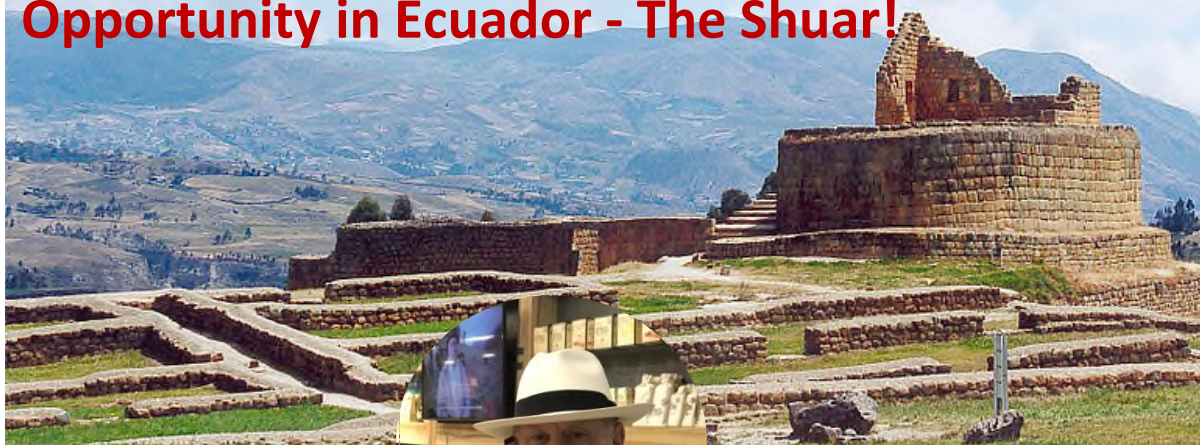

Dr. Zeinner and his fellow church member Nelson Fernandez landed in Quito, Ecuador on June 13th. Words cannot express the impact of this short mission trip. Landing at night in the Andes at over 9,200 feet altitude and then driving through those mountains two hours north to Ibarra was exhilarating. Dr. Zeinner preached Wednesday and Sunday at missionary Arian Molina's church in Ibarra. During this week they drove up into the Andes mountains where they visited several humble missions and Dr. Zeinner preached in one of the main churches. "It was awesome! We were greeted in those remote mountains with warm smiles, special music, testimonies and a positive response to our preaching. Their earnest request was for Bibles and tracts to pass out in the many villages." The main purpose was to meet in Quito with Missionary Victor Gallo the leader of the team wanting to make a new translation of the Shuar native language in the Amazon. "We discussed some very important issues and made ourselves available to help and train those that will work on this translation. I have written my assessment of our meeting and assured them that we are more than willing to come back to hold a Bible translation conference with his church and the translators."
