



It took a while, but the shipment of 178,800 John/Romans booklets and 2,760 whole French Bibles arrived in Lomé, Togo, West Africa the second week of June 2019. There were immediate problems. Steve Combs had worked with BPS Milford, our printer, to get all the necessary paperwork to Pastor Mawouli Gbolou. He had also wired over \$3,000 to Pastor Mawouli to pay for the port fees and taxes. In spite of all this, the port authorities were confused by an item on the paperwork and would not release the books. Again working with BPS Milford, we were able to send an additional document that cleared up the confusion. The books were immediately cleared for delivery and the churches have received them! Praise God!
